Membership Categories



UKRG Membership Categories

UKRG offers four categories of individual membership:

1. Individual Membership
2. Student Membership
3. Online only Membership
4. Associate Membership
5. Corporate Membership

These are open to anyone who meets the definition of a registrar as set out in the constitution: any person working in a museum, art gallery, collection or similar organisation that has a stated remit to collect, preserve, interpret and/or display objects of artistic, historical or scientific importance.

To apply, applicants should complete the online form on the UKRG website [Join us](#) page. The Membership Secretary will confirm receipt of the application and issue you with the payment instructions. You will also receive an automated email from UK Registrars Group with your log in details for the website. Once payment has been received the Treasurer will send you a receipt and your log in details will become active.

We accept payments for membership by credit/debit card or bank transfer. Please note that bank transfers may take significantly longer to process than payments received by card. If you do wish to pay by bank transfer, the Membership Secretary will send an invoice with payment details. Please ensure you include the invoice number with your payment.

The UKRG membership year runs from 1 April to 31 March, irrespective of the date of purchase.

The UK Registrars Group (UKRG) endeavours to protect your privacy. When you register to become a member, we will hold your personal data to administer your membership and communicate with you. Using the Account Details page when logged in to our website, you can amend your personal data at any time and can choose whether your details are visible to others on our members list. Your details will be held for the duration of your membership and for two years thereafter. After this period your details will be erased.

When you join UKRG you can choose if you details appear on our website via the membership list, which is available to all members when logged in. You can control if you appear on this list and which of your details are included through your account.

1. Individual Membership

Open to anyone who meets the definition of a registrar as set out in the constitution: any person working in a museum, art gallery, collection or similar organisation that has a stated remit to collect, preserve, interpret and/or display objects of artistic, historical or scientific importance.

The benefits of the Individual membership include:

- Free attendance of UKRG events
 - Monthly e-bulletin
 - Access to online resources
 - Access to the membership list
 - Feature on the membership list (optional)
 - Eligibility to vote in committee elections and at the AGM
 - Eligibility to apply for UKRG travel bursaries
 - Eligibility to stand for election to the committee
- £35 for one year, or £50 for two years.

2. Student Membership

Student membership is open to any students who are currently enrolled in a UK-based museum or heritage-related course. This membership category will also be offered to those undertaking an internship or volunteering in a UK-based museum, gallery, or heritage organisation.

This category is intended for those for whom study, volunteering, or internships represent their main professional focus, rather than activities undertaken alongside full-time employment in another field.

The benefits of the Student membership include:

- Free attendance of UKRG events
- Monthly e-bulletin
- Access to online resources
- Access to the membership list
- Feature on the membership list (optional)
- Eligibility to apply for UKRG travel bursaries

Benefits of the Student members do not include:

- Eligibility to vote in Committee Elections or at the AGM
 - Eligibility to stand for election to the committee.
- £17.50 for one year or £25 for two years.

3. Online only membership

Online membership is open to individuals who meet at least one of the following criteria:

1. Those based outside of the British Isles (England, Scotland, Wales, Northern Ireland, the Republic of Ireland, Isle of Man, Jersey, and Guernsey).

OR

2. Individuals who work for commercial companies, if their company has a Corporate membership

Benefits of the Online Only membership include:

- Monthly e-bulletin
- Access to online resources
- Access to the membership list
- Feature on the membership list (optional)

Benefits of the Online Only members do not include:

- Free access to UKRG events
 - Eligibility to stand for committee positions
 - Eligibility to vote for committee positions or at the AGM
 - Eligibility to apply for travel bursaries
- £15 for one year or £24 for two years

4. Associate membership

Associate Membership will be offered, to government agencies, sector bodies and subject specialist networks whose primary role is to support the Galleries, Museums, Heritage, Archives and Libraries sectors. It will offer the same benefits as a Standard Corporate Membership.

Benefits of the Associate Membership include:

- Free attendance of UKRG events for one representative
- Monthly e-bulletin
- Access to online resources
- Access to the membership list
- Services advertised on the website

Benefits of the Associate Membership do not include:

- Eligibility to vote in committee elections and at the AGM
- Eligibility to apply for UKRG travel bursaries
- Eligibility to stand for election to the committee

Associate membership will not be offered to individuals or to commercial companies.

- Free of charge

5. Corporate memberships

Corporate Membership is open to commercial companies who are involved in supplying a service to museum and heritage professionals.

There are 3 packages available:

- Standard Package / £500.00
- Premier Package / £1,000.00
- Deluxe Package / £2,000.00
